IHST Safety Experts Will Offer 11 Workshops and Seminars at Heli-Expo 2015

Group Also Will Host Worldwide Safety Panel Discussion on March 4th

Members of the International Helicopter Safety Team (www.IHST.org) will be providing their safety advice for Heli-Expo participants in Orlando at 11 different workshops and seminars.

The IHST leads a government and industry cooperative effort to promote safety and reduce civil helicopter accidents. Since the IHST's inception in 2005, the number of accidents worldwide has been decreasing by an annual rate of 2 percent, and the annual number of U.S. accidents has been reduced by 30 percent.
